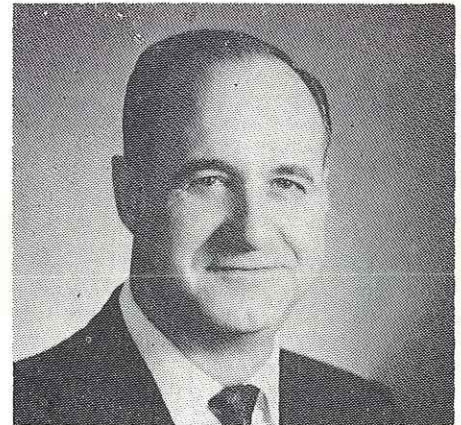

CALENDAR FOR
TEMPORARY PRETRIAL
RELIEF IN DISSOLUTION
CASES**

Effective immediately, the undersigned Judge will hear applications for Temporary Pretrial Relief in domestic matters by special appointments.

The following provisions apply:

1. FINANCIAL AFFIDAVITS are required.
2. Cases are limited to 10 minutes per side.
3. Counsel SHALL ALWAYS make appointments with Judge's Judicial Assistant and shall notice the opposing party in accordance with applicable Statutes and Rules of Procedures.
4. A copy of the Notice of Hearing, Motion and Financial Affidavit shall be in the hands of the Judge's Assistant four (4) days in advance of the hearing (not just the clerk).
5. Hearings will be set on Fridays between 2:30 P.M. and 4:00 P.M.
6. This calendar is intended for short Motions for Temporary Relief that require an evidentiary hearing and disposition within less than ten (10) days. Short procedural matters (non-evidentiary) may be set on the Judge's regular motion calendar from 8:45 A.M. to 9:30 A.M. (Monday thru Thursday). Lengthy hearing for Temporary Relief and those which do not require expeditious relief will not be heard on this calendar and may be referred to the General Master.

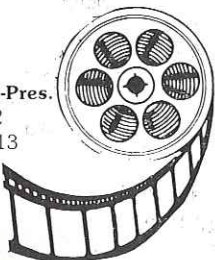

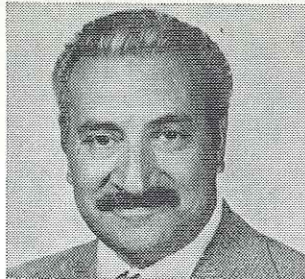
